Consider Christ in the Book of Mark

- A. What is the answer?
1. Because He B\_\_\_\_\_ all of our sins. – I Peter 2:24

- B. The answer was the motivating force that carried Christ through the...
1. Condescension of leaving \_\_\_\_\_ for a human body
  2. Life of being T\_\_\_\_\_ in all points like as we are, yet without sin. (Hebrews 4:15)
  3. Suffering and agony of the trial, scourging, and crucifixion. (Hebrews 12:2)
- V. He wanted \_\_\_\_\_ to F\_\_\_\_\_ on the "Why?"  
Only the death of the spotless Lamb of God could atone for the sin and wickedness of my life.

Consider Christ in the Book of Mark

- The most pivotal date in history is unquestionably \_\_\_\_\_
- I. The Lord Jesus Christ G\_\_\_\_\_ U\_\_\_\_\_ His Life (vs. 37)
- A. His death was His C\_\_\_\_\_
  - B. His life was not taken from Him. (John 10:17,18)  
"He gave up the G\_\_\_\_\_." –
  - C. His cry was "It is F\_\_\_\_\_." (John 19:30)
- II. Christ's death provided access to the holy God. (vs. 38)
- A. What is the V\_\_\_\_\_ of the Temple? Eph. 2:8-19  
Called the "middle W\_\_\_\_\_ of partition"
  - B. How was it removed?
    1. Through the P\_\_\_\_\_ of God
    2. Through the B\_\_\_\_\_ of Christ – Eph. 2:1
- III. Christ's death draws \_\_\_\_\_ people unto Himself (vs. 39)  
John 12:32,33; 3:14,15; Numbers 21:5-9  
"Look and Live" – LH #360  
Romans 10:9
- Applications
- I. He is in C\_\_\_\_\_ (vs. 37).  
(The Lord Jesus Christ gave up His life.)
- II. We must use that access in P\_\_\_\_\_ (vs. 38).  
(Christ death provided access to the holy God.)
- III. We must W\_\_\_\_\_ confidently, knowing He will draw the lost in conviction (vs. 39).  
(Christ death draws all people unto Himself.)
